Thank you for your interest in the Fort Detroit Golden Retriever Club (FDGRC). We are a not-for-profit organization dedicated to providing a forum for Golden Retriever related activities in the greater Southeastern Michigan area.

Membership in FDGRC is open to any person actively interested in promoting the aims of the Club and in promoting the betterment of the breed in general. The Club primarily meets several times per year to discuss business, communicate news, plan events, and offer education in the form of seminars or presentations on Golden Retriever related topics. At least once yearly FDGRC hosts an AKC sanctioned Specialty Show and Obedience Trial to showcase our Club and our breed in general. An AKC hunt test is usually held each summer, and various field training sessions are held throughout the year. The current roster of members includes people interested in all aspects of Golden Retriever ownership and can provide a wealth of knowledge on numerous dog related topics. We also offer social events such as the Club Annual Banquet in January and an occasional informal Club Picnic in the summer. Our club maintains a website in an effort to bring breed related educational material to a wide ranging audience and is closely allied to Golden Retriever Rescue of Michigan, a charitable organization operating to provide homes for displaced Golden Retrievers.

Requirements for joining our Club are quite simple. Attendance at three club functions within a 12 month period is mandatory prior to making application to join. These functions can be general meetings, assisting at club related functions or providing a service to the club. Attending an event as an exhibitor may not be included in the list of attended events. Once this requirement is met, your completed application is an indication of your intent to join. Prospective members' names are published in our next newsletter as notification to the membership at large of your intent. Your completed application, along with any comments received from the membership is reviewed by our Board of Directors at the next regularly convened Board Meeting. The review includes election to Member status should all requirements be met and it is agreed that you would prove an asset to our organization.

Meetings are typically held at the Leader Dogs For The Blind headquarters in Rochester, MI and usually occur at 7:30 PM on the third Tuesday of the months of March, April, May, September, October and November.

Dues can be summarized as follows:

Individual Member (18 and over) \$20.00 + \$10.00 initiation fee = \$30.00 Total Family Membership (2 Adults) \$25.00 + \$12.50 initiation fee = \$37.50 Total Associate Membership \$15.00 + no initiation fee = \$15.00 Total Junior Members (10-17 years old) No Dues or initiation fee

Associate Membership is available to those persons who do not wish to, or are unable to, actively participate in Club activities and functions. Associate members may not vote or hold office, nor receive annual awards and challenge trophies. They are entitled to notification of Club functions and to attend meetings.

All memberships include subscription to the *Michigolden Newsletter*, a publication used to communicate Club related information. The newsletter is produced several times per year, and you may elect to receive a paper version, rather than an electronic one.
