HRLRC 2016 RETRIEVER FIELD TRAINING DAYS



Participation fees - beginner and advanced

\$10 for members (limit 3 dogs) \$15 for non-members (limit 2 dogs)

Advanced: The advanced retriever is working at WC or JH level. This means that the dog readily picks up bumpers and birds, returns to the handler reliably, and ideally is getting close to delivering to hand.

Beginner: The beginner retriever category includes puppies and any older dogs that are still refining skills like their hold or recall.

Details (including any changes to start time and location address) will be provided by email prior to each training day.

You are encouraged to have the following items for you and your dog: (Be sure to put some form of ID on your equipment)

- Clean fresh water and bowl
- Flat buckle collar with short training tab about 10 inches
- Short 6 foot lead (dogs must be on lead unless being run or at honor)
- Long line
- Whistle
- Duck call

- Hearing protection
- First aid kit
- Dog kennel in vehicle
- Adequate clothing for weather conditions (including boots, rain gear, and/or sunscreen)
- Chair
- Lunch

New members and handlers are urged to attend and participate in the training sessions even though they have not yet purchased all of the necessary equipment, but it is strongly recommended that they do so as soon as possible so they are fully prepared at future training sessions. A small selection of basic training equipment may be available for sale at each training day.

Please come ready to work together to provide a great training day for everybody. Field committee members are happy to provide advice and instruction on throwing bumpers, using popper guns and launchers, and assisting dogs in the field, and we ask that all handlers pitch in as they are able. Bill shares his training methods and secrets to produce a fabulous retriever, whether you are interested in a family dog, a hunting dog, or a dog for hunt test and field trial competition. While owners of dogs at all levels will benefit from this seminar, specific focus is on retrievers in the Basics and Transition stages of their careers. To illustrate specific concepts and drills, Bill will work throughout the course of the seminar with various dog/handler teams but every dog will not run every setup.

Topics to be covered include:

- Teaching the "Fetch" command (a/k/a "force breaking")
- Bill's famous "Traffic Cop" method of teaching the SIT command and reinforcing the SIT command with the electric collar and other stimuli and distractions
- Understanding how to create an electronic signal between you and your dog using the "soft collar" method
- Fundamentals on land and in the water: casting, pile work, single T, Powercast, water T, swim by, cheating marks, lining and casting drills
- Next steps up from foundation work
