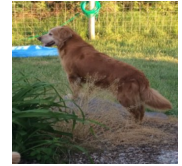
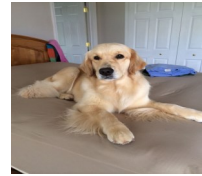
And a couple of weekends later.....
