


FDGRC ALL BREED RALLY TRIAL February 8-9, 2025

Fort Detroit Golden Retriever Club awarded its first annual Junior Performance Handler Award using the scores compiled by the AKC for their Junior program, and including Handlers in Obedience, Rally, Agility, Scentwork, Field, and Tracking. Junior handlers from Michigan, but with any breed are eligible for this \$250 award. Our first recipient is Evelyn Cunningham, a Scentwork handler of a Bulldog named Guppy, and a Border Collie named Hootie.

President's Letter 2024

Fort Detroit has had a wonderful year in 2024!

We put on 4 Specialty Shows including 2 Sweepstakes, at Monroe County Fairgrounds----two each on consecutive days. Prizes included decorated water buckets and tumblers, crafted by Kim Salyers, and other donations from our members. We held a raffle for a cooler of beverages, and a tower of games as a fundraiser. Both were very popular!

We held two Agility Trials at All Dogs Can in Lapeer. Lots of entries, lots of fun, and lots of agility success!

Our meetings focused on things that Goldens can do:

This year, MI Golden Fit Club was formed as an AKC club for keeping dogs healthy by walking. The club walked the Paint Creek trail (to a cider mill), the Polly Ann trail (to an ice cream shop), the Metamora village trail, the Clinton River Trail (to another ice cream shop), and in December met at Partridge Creek Mall for pictures with Santa and a walk to Three Dog Bakery for treats!

We had a speaker from the USA Therapy Dog organization and heard from Diana Vavra about therapy dog training and the benefit to people they visit. We also saw the video from GRCA about holding a Certificate of Conformation Assessment, to see if it was something we might be interested in doing (probably not right away!) We visited Dianne Baker and watched judge Pete Stager evaluate her recent litter. We included our dogs again with a visit to Sue Coppen's Pumpkin Patch, and we heard about healthy dog treats from Andrea at Pupper Budder Dog Treats in Oxford.

We had donations of three new trophies—one for the sport of Rally, one for Scentwork, and one for Therapy dog work. These will be awarded for the first time today. As our club community outreach, we designated \$250 for an award for the High Scoring AKC Performance Junior Handler in Michigan. This was awarded last weekend to Evie Cunningham, a 10 year old Scentwork handler. (photo on the trophy table).

We also honored our FDGRC performance dogs with a full photo page in the GRCA News.

Many FDGRC dogs have been very successful in many venues this year!! Looking forward to 2025, we have been planning to hold a RALLY Trial at Companion Dog Training Club on February 8-9. We hope many of you will compete, and/or assist and volunteer with this endeavor.

So FDGRC has many things to look back on proudly this year----we had fun with our dogs, made lots of friends, and have momentum going forward to a great 2025.


